Please pray for a **sponsor for AMG national leader Hisar Manurung**. He serves as a church planter in **Indonesia** while facing all the challenges of frequent natural disasters, rugged terrain, and threatening religious environments. Hisar ministers among the Islamic people in Indonesia with his wife, Romanti. He serves his community as a church planter, pastor, and counselor. A sponsorship will help provide Hisar with the resources he needs to meet the practical needs of his family and obtain resources that will help him spread the Good News to those who have never heard the gospel.

Sitikorn is a happy little boy in **Thailand**. He lives in a Buddhist home with his parents and sister. His father works in landscaping, while his mother sells small supplies. They work hard, but their income is not enough to cover all of the family's expenses, including Sitikorn's schooling. At the child and youth development center, Sitikorn will receive nutritious food, clothing, assistance with education costs, and medical care. Also, he will experience the love of Jesus and receive teaching from the Word of God.

This week, please pray for the **Berita Hidup radio ministry**. It is based in **Solo City, Indonesia**, and has been on the air for more than 15 years, reaching nearly 900,000 people in a country with the highest Muslim population. The ministry has a daily one-hour live program with worship music and a message from God's Word. During the program, listeners can call in with questions and prayer requests. In Indonesia alone, 3,000 people participate in our Bible correspondence courses each month.

Week 1: May 1–9

This week, please pray for a **sponsor for AMG national leader Carlos Alvarez**. He is involved in church planting and pastoral ministry in **Spain**. He came to know Christ while completing a master's degree in business. His faith quickly matured while serving as a volunteer with the various evangelistic outreaches of his church, and his role shifted to focus on leadership. Carlos was ordained by AMG Spain and has the opportunity to proclaim the gospel in several countries.

Please pray for a **sponsor for** this week's child, **Adhea**, a sweet little girl living in the **Philippines**. Her father is a mason worker, but his income is not enough to provide for his family. Due to their lack of sufficient income, Adhea needs a sponsor to continue her studies. With a sponsor, Adhea will have many of her basic needs provided, including education fees and weekly Bible lessons at the AMG child and youth development center.

Please pray for **AMG Uganda's radio ministry** this week. For the last 18 years, AMG Uganda has hosted a unique program that airs Sunday mornings and has a listenership of more than 12 million people. Programs range from evangelistic, discipleship, and doctrinal teachings, including topics on salvation, leadership, family, education and panel discussions.

Week 2: May 10–16

Please pray for a **sponsor for AMG national leader Darmawan Pasaribu**. He was born into a Christian family in **Indonesia**. However, the village he grew up in was very secular. Darmawan accepted Jesus as his personal Lord and Savior when he was older after attending church services. He went on to study theology and discovered that God was calling him to ministry. He now serves the people of Indonesia as a church planter, primarily among Buddhists.

Please pray for a **sponsor for Adrian**, a little boy in **Uganda**. His father is a construction worker, but he works on temporary contracts, and it is not easy for him to earn enough to provide for his family. A lot of the time, they do not have enough money for the children's school fees; however, Adrian's parents are determined for him to receive an education. A sponsorship will bless Adrian with the opportunity to receive

help with schooling, nutritious meals, medical care and instruction from God's Word.

This week, please pray for **our radio ministry in Cyprus**. The station reaches 20,000 daily listeners with a potential audience of 800,000 people. Those who respond to the radio broadcasts receive a New Testament, a copy of the Jesus Film, and personal contact from national leaders serving at the station. Speaking with our national leaders allows listeners to get acquainted with biblical truths in a safe environment where they can explore the Christian faith.

Week 3: May 17–23

Please pray for a **sponsor for AMG national leader Febrian Lumintang** serving with **AMG Indonesia** at **Berita Hidup Seminary**, an especially vital resource available to those preparing to serve as pastors and church planters in Indonesia. Staff members like Febrian play an essential role in the operation of the seminary while performing many administrative functions. Today, Febrian works diligently in several areas of ministry, but he is most passionate about reaching young people in his community.

Please pray for a **sponsor for Alicia**, a sweet little girl who lives in **Guatemala**. Her father works as a farmer harvesting beans. However, he does not have a permanent job, which makes it challenging to provide for all of the family's needs. With a sponsor, Alicia can continue attending school, and the child and youth development center would provide her with nutritious food, clothing, medical care, and teaching from the Bible.

This week, please pray for **our media evangelism ministry in Lebanon**. Two of our **national leaders, Robert & Micheline Dfouni**, run a Facebook page called **Yom Jdid (New Day)** as a part of their ministry. The page creates a space for Muslims, atheists, and people of other religions to have a safe place to ask questions. The Dfounis do not respond directly to comments on the page, but rather message each individual. Many messages lead to in-person meetings where the gospel is presented. The majority of their correspondents are young men from a Muslim background who are seeking the Truth.
